



LICE ALERT

Dear Parent,

We have discovered an outbreak of head lice at this school/centre. This is not a cause for concern, as your child may not be affected. However, head lice are extremely contagious.

In order to determine if your child has been infected with head lice, we are asking all parents to inspect their child's hair. We suggest that you look for the following symptoms or signs that would indicate the presence of head lice:

- General: child scratching his/her head excessively.
- On pillows: fine black powder or pale coloured remnants.
- In the hair: signs of lice eggs ('nits') - cream or coffee coloured specks close to hair roots.
- Lice: small white or 'greyish' parasites the approximate size of a pin-head.

If you notice any of the above signs, or if you require further information, please contact your local pharmacy, as treatment is readily available and easy to apply.

We encourage you to ensure that this problem is solved quickly by determining if your child is affected and seeking recognised head lice treatment if necessary.
